She has put Lauralton in the strongest financial position in its history through prudent financial management and by building our fundraising to new levels, including the recently announced <u>legacy donation</u>, our largest ever.

Elizabeth led efforts to enhance our curriculum and upgrade facilities to advance our mission of preparing graduates to succeed in college and throughout their lives while maintaining a commitment to the compassionate service and responsible leadership that are the hallmarks of a Mercy education.
