

**PARENT AGREEMENT FOR BUS SERVICE: 2018-2019 ACADEMIC YEAR**

**COST:** The annual fee for bus transportation to and from Lauralton Hall on regularly scheduled school days is \$850 per student. The non-refundable fee of \$850 is payable in full by June 15, 2018. Space is limited on each bus. Registration is on a “first come, first served” basis upon receipt of full payment of \$850 and the signed agreement.

**ROUTE:**

**MORNING**

Commuter lot at Route 25 and Route 111 Trumbull/Monroe– approximately 6:50 a.m., depart at 6:55 a.m.

Trumbull Public Library – approximately 7:05 a.m., depart at 7:10 a.m.

Newtown Public Library – approximately 6:45 a.m., depart at 7:00 a.m.

Rite Aid lot at Route 25 and Route 59 Easton/Monroe – approximately 7:10 a.m., depart at 7:16 a.m.

Ridgefield Public Library – approximately 6:45 a.m., depart at 6:50 a.m.

Wilton Public Library – approximately 7:00 a.m., depart 7:05 a.m.

Arrive at Lauralton Hall no later than 7:40 a.m.

**AFTERNOON** – Leave Lauralton Hall at 3:15 p.m.

Trumbull Public Library – arrive approximately 3:55 p.m.

Commuter lot at Route 25 and Route 111 Trumbull/Monroe – arrive approximately 3:35 p.m.

Rite Aid lot at Route 25 and Route 59 Easton/Monroe – arrive approximately 3:55 p.m.

Newtown Public Library – arrive approximately 4:25 p.m.

Ridgefield Public Library – arrive approximately 4:20 p.m.

Wilton Public Library – arrive approximately 3:50 p.m.

If school is delayed in the morning, times will be 90 minutes later than posted above.

Any concerns about the bus should be directed to Winkle Bus Co, Inc. at 203-878-6912.

Driver will follow the route as stated unless she/he deems it necessary to change the route due to traffic or construction. In the case of inclement weather, Lauralton Hall shall determine when school shall be in session, when the opening of school shall be delayed, and when early dismissal shall take place, and bus transportation will be provided in accordance with such determination. Parents are responsible for arranging transportation to/from the pick-up/drop off points. The bus must adhere to a schedule and will not wait for tardy students or parents who are “on the way”. Students are not to run to the bus from parked or standing cars – safety of the riders and pedestrians is paramount. Students must be cautious in the parking lots. No texting while walking to/from the bus.

**DISCIPLINE:** Standing or loud, disruptive or other unacceptable behavior on the bus is not allowed. Lauralton Hall is responsible for enforcement of discipline and security on the bus as stated in the *Lauralton Hall Student/Parent Handbook of Standards and Expectations* and reserves the right to refuse transportation to any student who is disruptive or creates an unsafe condition for others. Bus driver has the right to discipline students by arranging seating or reporting misbehavior to Lauralton Hall’s Dean of Student Development.
