#### **CAMP SAFETY**

- Face masks will be required while at camp.
   Campers will have mask breaks and water breaks.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided along with hand washing breaks and enhanced cleaning of surfaces.
- ✓ Each camp during each week will be treated as a cohort with a maximum of 16 campers. Two staff + two Lauralton Hall CITs will be assigned to each camp. Each camp will have their own space within our 25+ acres to explore and have fun!
- ✓ In the unfortunate event that someone in your child's camp cohort test positive, camps will continue virtually via Zoom.

#### **SUPPLIES & SNACKS**

- Campers will be provided their supplies for the week and will be responsible to bring the materials with them to camp.
- ✓ We are a completely NUT FREE camp.

  Do not send your child to camp with any nut products. A nut-free snack cart will be circulating during snack time with goodies for purchase.
- ✓ Each camp will have a fifteen minute snack break.

✓ We offer SNACK PACKS for just \$3/day or \$12/week where your camper will get to choose from either a juice box / Gatorade and then two snacks. One healthy: either apples, a cheese stick or GoGurt, and one treat: Chips or cookies daily.

#### DROP OFF/PICK UP

- ✓ Designated drop off and pick up locations:
  - Athletic Turf Field–Zone 1 (Left of the School Entrance)
  - Art Rooms-Zone 2 (To the right of the Entrance through the round-about)
  - Athletic Center-Zone 3 (Building on the left of campus)
  - Hogwarts-Zone 4 (Behind the school at the Carousel)
- ✓ For everyone's safety, drop off and pick up times are staggered in order to control the number of people on campus. We ask that all families follow the instructions below.
  - Zone 1 and 2: 8:45 am dropoff, Pickup 12:15
  - Zone 3 and 4: 9:00 am dropoff, Pickup 12:30
- ✓ Our one-way drive-through drop off and pick allows for quick convenience and ensures the safety of all campers and counselors. Entrance to campus is through our main gates on High Street. This will be the way to drop off and pick up campers.

#### Future of S.T.E.M.

This NEW course focuses on S.T.E.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) and campers will learn to be problem solvers and to use critical thinking skills. Working in our Innovation Lab, and utilizing their imagination, campers will explore the practical world of science. This class will focus on different areas of study such as projectiles, forces, and energy, competing in a Science Olympics. Campers will work with technology by working in Adobe Photoshop and mastering picture composition through units on photography. Campers will work with practical engineering to solve problems, and work with block coding and will learn to design character movements with mini applications for a week of interactive fun!

Campers should bring their own cameras and cell phones daily for use. Permission slip required for this course as campers will walk off campus daily under the supervision of their counselors to photograph a variety of objects and subjects. \$210/session.
